*Youth participants must be 14 on October 1 of the current 4-H year and volunteer chaperones must be at least 21 and a certified volunteer.*

**Those participants interested in attending need to register through 4-H online. There is a registration worksheet for counties to distribute in order to collect registration information. Please contact your county Extension office for registration specifics.**

Each county may send any number of county Ambassadors, teen leaders, volunteers and Extension Staff. The 4-H Center will make lodging arrangements for all Fall Training participants. Keep in mind that there will be four people to a double room. Chaperons have the option of two people rather than four to a room for an additional cost. This can be indicated during registration.
