Youth participants must be 14 on October 1, 2018 and volunteer chaperones must be at least 21 and a certified volunteer.

Those participants interested in attending need to register online at montana4h.org. There is a registration worksheet for counties to distribute in order to collect registration information. Please contact your county Extension office for registration specifics.

Each county may send any number of county Ambassadors, teen leaders, volunteers and Extension Staff. The 4-H Center will make lodging arrangements for all Fall Training participants. Keep in mind that there will be four people to a double room. Chaperons have the option of two people rather than four to a room for an additional cost. Adult room preference can be indicated during registration.
