SHOOTING SPORTS CODE OF ETHICS

A complete 4-H Shootings Sports program must convey life skills development and be presented in such a way that is safe, technically competent and helps to instill 4-H values in participants through teaching and example. Certified Shooting Sports Instructors and Volunteers must be cognizant of their role as a moral and ethical mentor, as well as teacher to youth and adults in their state and community.

CERTIFIED 4-H SHOOTING SPORTS LEADERS AGREE TO:

- Respect the participants, volunteers and property associated with the 4-H shooting sports program.
- Set a good example as a mentor, and role model for 4-H shooting sports youth and volunteer leaders.
- Conduct myself and my program in a professional, ethical manner.
- Strive to be knowledgeable of the life skills embodied in the 4-H shooting sports program and aid positively in the development of youth through adherence to those principals.
- Strive to be technically competent in the subject matter I teach and adhere to 4-H shooting sports guidelines and principles.
- Respect the dignity of each participant regardless of gender, origin, ability, achievement or convictions.
