

2020-2021 Madison Valley 4-H Archery Shooting Sports Postal Tournament

The Madison Valley 4-H Shooting Sports Leaders would like to invite any county that has an active 4-H archery shooting sports program to participate in a postal tournament. We have included the information, rules, and procedures below.

This Postal Shoot is not a live tournament. These scores will be shot at the participants' home range or course during their practice sessions or however their instructor chooses. Scores will be sent to us for placement.

GENERAL RULES

This tournament is open to any participant of a current 4-H archery shooting sports program. 4-H membership is required to participate and receive awards. Youth must be 9 years old by October 1st, 2020 to participate. It is each county's responsibility to check their members' ages as listed on the results sheet.

AGE CLASSIFICATIONS

9 & 10-year-olds, 11 & 12-year-olds, 13 & 14-year-olds, 15 to 19-year-olds

DIVISIONS

Maximum of 3 divisions may be shot per archer

1. Unlimited – compound, moveable sights or fixed sights and release, stabilizer 12 inches and over
2. Bowhunter – compound, moveable sights or fixed sights and release, stabilizer 12 inches or less
3. Limited – compound, fixed sights, and fingers
4. Barebow – compound, no sights, and fingers
5. Primitive – recurve or longbow, no sights, and fingers
6. Olympic Recurve – recurve, sights, fingers, and stabilizer

NO changing bows after the start of the tournament.

COSTS AND REGISTRATION

The cost is \$10.00 per shooter, per division. Each shooter may register for no more than 3 divisions. Please make checks payable to MVSS (Madison Valley Shooting Sports)

Please register the name and age of each shooter on the attached registration form by March 8, 2021. Email your counties participants registration list to iconarchery@gmail.com

Payment for all participants must be turned in no later than the receipt of final scores. If payment for a participant is not received by the time the final scores are received, that participant's score will not be accepted. Please send registration form & payment to:

SCORING

Targets are to be scored by a Montana 4-H certified shooting sports leader. Targets will need to be shot and scored by March 26, 2021. **State tournament scores may not be used.** Participants can practice for as many or few weeks as desired. However, they must decide prior to shooting the postal tournament target that it will be the one to be scored. Do not shoot multiple sets of targets and choose the best score for inclusion in the postal match. **Only 1 score to be turned in per division per shooter.**

National Standard rules are followed by all divisions.

All targets and scorecards must be kept on file until April 30, 2021. In the event of a challenge, contested targets must be sent to the coordinator for inspection. Otherwise, do not send in targets.

SENDING IN SCORES

Please submit final scores on the attached final score sheet. **All final score sheets and fees need to be postmarked by April 1, 2021.** When sending in scores and fees, please include the county name on all correspondence. **Do not send in targets.** Only raw scores are needed. Please indicate the submission method on the final score sheet to eliminate confusion when sending in both. **Scores sent via email only will not be accepted until payment is received.** Please send final score sheet to:

ARCHERY POSTAL SHOOT COMPETITION PROCEDURES

COURSE OF FIRE

Competition should be as follows:

1. Shooters must shoot either a 40 cm 10 ring target or a Vegas Three-Spot target.
2. Thirty arrows at 10 meters (10 rounds of 3 arrows) – 300 points maximum.
3. Shooters may straddle the shooting line, one foot on each side of the line.

SCORING

1. The 10-ring target: score 10x, 10, 9, 8, etc. down to 1.
2. The Vegas 3 spot target: score 10x, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6.
3. If the arrow touches the higher scoring line, the shooter gets the higher score.
4. Misfired arrows can be retrieved if the arrow is within 5 feet of the shooting line.
5. If an arrow bounces out of the target, it may be re-shot.
6. Targets may be used more than once.
7. A shooting sports leader must score targets.

AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded for up to the 5th place in each division. Results and any awards will be mailed to the participating county's MSU Extension Office.
